CLASS: 6; SUBJECT: SCIENCE

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Identify and differentiate: Leaves with parallel and reticulate venation, plants with taproot and fibrous roots, plants having monocot seeds and dicot seeds, terrestrial and aquatic animals, components of food, magnetic and non-magnetic materials, different types of motions, hard and soft materials, soluble and insoluble materials, transparent, translucent and opaque materials, mass and volume, Celsius, Fahrenheit and Kelvin scale.

Conduct investigations: Test for starch and proteins in food, Magnetic and non-magnetic substances, finding directions with the help of compass, finding the boiling and freezing point of water, Factors affecting evaporation, conditions for germination of a seed, solubility of substances in water and oil.

Explain processes and phenomena: Conversion of different states of matter, process of evaporation and condensation, different methods of separation, life cycle of a mosquito and a frog, rainwater harvesting.
