SUBJECT: MATHEMATICS

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Students will be able to

- **A Square and A Cube**
identify perfect squares and perfect cubes, find square roots and cube roots using appropriate methods, apply squares and cubes in problem solving situations.

apply laws of exponents, express numbers in standard form, simplify numerical and algebraic expressions involving powers.

state and explain the Pythagoras theorem, find unknown sides of a right triangle, apply the theorem in practical problems.
- **Proportional Reasoning – 2**
identify inverse proportion, solve problems involving direct and inverse variation, apply proportional reasoning in contextual situations.
- **Exploring some Geometric Themes**
identify geometric patterns and relationships.
- **Tales by Dots and Lines**
plot points on the Cartesian plane, draw simple graphs, interpret graphical information.
- **Algebra Play**
factorise algebraic expressions, use algebraic identities in factorisation, solve equations using factorisation method.
- **Area**
calculate area of polygons, find surface area and volume of solids, solve practical mensuration problems.

Identify and differentiate: Elements, Compounds and Mixtures, Solute, Solvent and Solutions, Concave and Convex-Mirrors and Lenses, Various Phases of Moon, Mass and Weight, Sexual and Asexual reproduction in plants and animals, Food chain and Food web.

Conduct investigations: Formation of compound from a mixture, solubility of some common substances, pressure exerted by liquid, staining onion peel to observe the cells, conductors and insulators of electricity, electromagnets, factors affecting heating and magnetic effect of current, factors affecting the solubility of a substance, measure mass and volume of an object, laws of reflection.

Explain processes and phenomena: Factors affecting evaporation of water, formation of storms and cyclones, reflection and refraction through plane mirror, spherical mirrors, formation of phases of moon, interdependence of organisms, pressure exerted by solids, liquids, diffusion in states of matter.

Write word equations & use scientific language: Reactions between elements to form compounds.
